The Workshop Presenters

The presenters for the workshop this year will be various experienced Intentional Interim Ministers who have had several years of experience working in the field of helping congregations during the time of transition between settled pastors. This period is different than most other periods in the life of a congregation and brings its own unique challenges and opportunities. The content of the sessions will be that used by the presenters over the last several years, but this year, instead of one just presenter, there will be a variety of presenters each bringing his or her own unique insights and perspectives.

About This Training...

This 3-day training event is a basic level training that will qualify a pastor to work as an interim minister here in Ohio. It is, however, only the first step for those truly interested in this specialized field of ministry. If you feel called to this work, we encourage you to continue your education with further training from the Interim Ministry Network (www.imnedu.org). This organization has developed the “gold standard” for interim ministry training, and their training is recognized by other denominations and judicatories along with those here in Ohio. Interim ministry is important work, and we encourage pastors to seriously explore developing their expertise in this important field.

Who Should Attend?

This workshop is for any pastor (Disciples of Christ or United Church of Christ) interested in serving as an interim minister in Ohio. The period of transition that occurs while a congregation searches for a settled pastor can be an especially fruitful time. It is during this time that the church has an important opportunity to do the work of reevaluating, refocusing, healing, and “cleaning up.” The interim time is much more than just a period of biding time; it is a time of making valuable preparations that can strengthen the church’s ministry for many years to come. If you have an interest in helping congregations in transition, this workshop can be your first step in developing that ministry.
