



HYGIENE KITS LIST

When people are forced to abruptly leave their homes because of emergencies, they may not have time to pack the things they use on a daily basis like toothbrushes or soap. But after a few days without these items, they definitely miss them. Your hygiene kits offer a refreshing daily boost for someone when supplies are hard to come by. Please remember to send \$2/kit to FOS to cover the costs of processing.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- One hand towel measuring approximately 15" x 28" to 16" x 32" (no fingertip, bath, dish towel, or micro-fiber)
- One washcloth
- One wide-tooth comb removed from the package (found at discount dealers like sallybeauty.com)
 - Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth
 - No pocket combs or picks
 - Rattail and combs without handles are acceptable, must have at least 6" of teeth
- One fingernail or toenail clipper removed from the package (either one is acceptable)
- One bath size bar of soap in the original package
- One toothbrush in the original package
- Ten standard size Band-Aids

All items need to fit inside a one-gallon Ziploc type bag. Remove the excess air from the bag and seal before boxing. Do not add any extra items or toothpaste. A tube of extended expiration date toothpaste will be added to each hygiene kit just prior to its journey.

SCHOOL KITS LIST

Starting a new school year is exciting...but for children who don't have school supplies, it can also be terrifying. That's where these kits - and your compassion - come in! Plus, the fabric bag you pack each kit in provides a long-lasting gift that kids can carry to and from school! Please remember to send \$2/kit to FOS to cover the costs of processing.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip, only)
- Three 70-count bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (no loose-leaf or filler paper)
- One 30-centimeter, 12" ruler
- One hand-held pencil sharpener (removed from package)
- One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers (with pencils removed from the package)
- One box of 24 crayons
- One 12" x 14" to 14" x 17" finished size cotton or lightweight canvas bag with handles (solid color or kid-friendly fabric, no logos, reusable shopping bags or backpacks)



All items must be packed inside of the bag. The MyShopAngel website has an affordable CWS Kit bag option for bulk purchase. Visit [cwskits.org/bag](https://www.cwskits.org/bag) to order. *Optional: Loose school kit items may be placed in a large Ziploc type bag to keep them together. Remove the air, seal the bag and place inside of the cotton/canvas bag.*

CLEANUP BUCKET LIST

A bucket is full of home-recovery supplies that are needed after a disaster strikes.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- One five-gallon bucket with resealable lid (if reused, scrub clean. Do not use a bucket that has held chemicals of any kind)
- Four scouring pads
- Seven sponges, including one large
- One scrub brush
- 18 reusable, lightweight dry cleaning towels (e.g. Handi wipes)
- One 50oz. or two 25oz. bottle(s) of liquid laundry detergent
- One 16-28oz. bottle of liquid disinfectant dish soap
- One 12-17oz. bottle of household cleaner that can be mixed with water (no spray bottles)
- One package of 48-50 clothespins
- Clothesline, two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.
- Five dust masks
- Two pairs of heavy-duty, waterproof dishwashing gloves (latex-free, non-surgical)
- One pair of work gloves (cotton with leather palm or all leather)
- 24-28 heavy duty or contractor type 30-45 gallon trash bags on a roll and removed from carton
- One 6-9oz. bottle of non-aerosol insect repellent



All cleaning items must be new and all liquid items must be capped and securely tightened. Fitting all of the items into the bucket can be a challenge. Watch the how-to video at fosohio.org/bucket-video. Place the larger items into the bucket first, then add the smaller items. Make sure everything is packed securely to avoid damage during shipment. Snap the lid on tight and seal with packing tape.

CWS Welcome Backpacks is how we ensure our newly arriving neighbors have essentials like food, water, blankets, hygiene items and a warm welcome home.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Backpack - 17"
- All-season blanket - 50"x60"
- Coloring book
- Crayons - 24 pack
- Two pads of paper - 8.5"x11"
- Three pens
- One two-pocket folder

IN A GALLON-SIZE ZIPLOC:

- Five fruit leather strips
- Four protein bars
- Ten granola bars
- Six fruit & grain bars
- Four trail mix pouches - 1.75oz.

IN A 2.5 GALLON-SIZE ZIPLOC:

- Two bottles of hand sanitizer - 2oz.
- One Chapstick
- Ten hair ties
- One small travel hairbrush
- Four toothpaste/toothbrush packs
- Three packs of tissues
- Ten disposable masks
- One travel deodorant
- Ten tampons
- Ten sanitary napkins
- One pack of cleaning/baby wipes

All items must fit inside their respective ziploc bags. Remove the excess air from the bags and seal before placing them in backpack. Please do not include cash or coins with backpacks.
